

Frequently Asked Questions on Terminal B

Q: How much will this cost?

A: The first phase that we are starting today is a \$160 million project. Phase 2 and 3 are planned over the next seven to 10 years, based on demand and economic conditions.

Construction value of all three phases is estimated at \$1 billion.

Q: What is the biggest change that the public will notice?

United will expand the gate area significantly and the latest in technology will help with the boarding process.

Q: Why is it a “green” terminal?

A: The design offers energy-efficient techniques using Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) criteria.

Q: What will happen after the first phase?

A: Phase 2 and 3 will provide new piers on the north side of Terminal B, a new check-in lobby and baggage systems, and if demand warrants, a new Federal Inspection Facility (FIS) for international arrivals.

Q: When will the project be completed?

A: Phase one is expected to be completed in the third quarter of 2013. Construction of the entire redevelopment project is planned over a span of seven to 10 years.
