- The Houston Airport System (HAS) is the fourth-largest airport system in the United States and the sixth-largest in the world
- Considered a primary gateway to Latin America
- According to a 2003 economic impact study, HAS supports over 151,000 regional jobs and contributes over \$24 billion to the local economy
- The three-airport system – George Bush Intercontinental Airport, William P. Hobby Airport and Ellington Airport - served over 50 million passengers in 2008
- Bush Intercontinental Airport offers service to more Mexican destinations than any other airport in the country
- HAS does not use local tax dollars and is entirely self-supporting through user fees and lease agreements
